

Street Food Friday: The Blind Pig Parks Outside The Gates in Key West



We recently reported on the opening of **Key West**'s newest hotel, **The Gates**, and now we learned of a delightful food truck parked permanently outside: **The Blind Pig** with a motto of "Small Bites Done Right." Sadly we couldn't make it to the Southernmost Point to taste for ourselves, but we have a very reliable foodie who assures us the small bites are indeed done right.



The Blind Pig serves breakfast from 7:00 to 11:00 am while lunch and dinner is available from 11:00 am to 10:00 pm. To start the day one might opt for the Hotsy Totsy Taco, a breakfast taco of scrambled eggs, aged cheddar cheese, pico de gallo and avocado slices (\$4). For lunch try the Flapper in a Wrapper – a grilled chicken wrap on a whole wheat tortilla with wildberry mint vinagrette, arugula, crushed apples and herb feta (\$7). Then come back for dinner and order the its namesake, The Blind Pig: smokey pulled pork meat, aged cheddar cheese with cider barbecue glaze and sweet onions served on pretzel bread (\$7).



Then there is the I.R.S. (irresitable snacks) section of the menu (\$4 each) with items such as truffle popcorn, devils on horseback, salt and vinegar hand-sliced chips and fries with parmesan cheese.

We venture to say this is not your typical food truck. So get yourselves on the nearest highway heading south and don't stop until you reach the Conch Republic. First stop? The Blind Pig.
