
thing that is truly authentic Key West. From the historical component that made our island what it was prior to tourism driving the economy; the cigar trade, the Prohibition years and more."

ARTISAN PARTNERS

Rum Row is The Gates' contemporary rum bar adjacent to the hotel's pool deck. With a nod to the Prohibition era and the indelible characters and culture it yielded during its history. The Gates has partnered with Key West First Legal Rum Distillery. White rum drinks made with Florida sugarcane and finished with infusions of coconut, vanilla crème brûlée and real key lime are offered in the company of a selection of handcrafted cocktails inspired by Key West history. "Up in Smoke" features First Legal's raw and unfiltered rum, its name a salute to the island's cigar industry. The Tomoka Mojito takes its name from a famous rum-running ship. You may decide to choose one of the aged and dark sipping rums or the private label Gates rum, exclusive to the hotel and billed as perfect pairings with a Rodriguez cigar.

The Gates has also partnered with the Rodriguez Cigar Factory, a family-owned enterprise that has been continuously operating in Key West since 1984; the cigar company draws its inspiration from the days when cigar making was introduced to the island. Rodriguez hand-rolled cigars are made in traditional Cuban style and are offered in an extensive selection of premium blends.



"This has been a wonderful partnership for us," Happ said. "We have created an outdoor Rodriguez Cigar Lounge and we have a beautiful humidor in the lobby for guests to select their cigars and enjoy them in the garden. The cigar fun goes beyond relaxing with your favorite pairing of a sipping rum and your smoke. We have cigar rolling and Dominoes nights and they

are really fun 'Havana Nights' type of events."

Another Key West partner of The Gates that you will see throughout the hotel and in its 100 boutique-style rooms are photographs by Jorge de la Torriente of De La Gallery. The award-winning photographer's use of light, color and compo-

sition are a perfect complement to the interior's neutral tones.

When you select The Gates for your stay, you have selected a truly Key West destination. Enjoy. PBG


