While staying in Old Town makes for easy access to all the shops, bars, restaurants and activity on Duval Street, there is a quieter side to Key West, New Town. Away from the hustle and bustle, The Gates Hotel offers chic, boutique style accommodations. Poolside at The Gates offers a perfect spot to relax with a handcrafted cocktail from Rum Row, while listening to live music or the DJ spinning tunes. The Blind Pig food truck provides a rotating menu of tapas-style entrees, known as Conch Fusion with its Cuban, Bahamian and Caribbean flavors.

The Gates has partnered with many

local brands and artists to provide unique experiences for its guests. Try a cigar from Rodriguez Cigar Factory or a drink made with white rum from Key West First Legal Rum Distillery, for a taste of the rich history of the island. A chef first, then distiller, Paul Menta, owner and operator of the Key West First Legal Rum Distillery, uses his knowledge of cooking to incorporate new techniques for distilling rums. Menta provides daily tours of his operations and shows his passion for creating tasty and unique rums. Enjoy the tasting room and be sure to take home a bottle or two, to remember and celebrate the memories made in Key West. M
